Green River Area with the Solitary Angler on 19/20/21 July

I have reserved six positions for three days of guided fishing with the Solitary Angler in southwestern Wyoming. As of now all six positions are filled. If others are interested let me know as there may be cancellations. If this trip proves successful will try and schedule again next year. Van Beacham of Solitary Angler was our guest speaker for the month of Oct., sounded like he offers a unique fishing experience in areas that many people have never heard about. The three days will include one day floating the Green River through the Seedskafee National Wildlife Refuge below Fontenelle Dam, one day of guided fishing on Ham's fork and one day of guided fishing on Smith's Fork plus a morning of fishing on our own.
